

Farewell III

Westphalian, Dark Bay, born 2000, 17.1 hands



Dethroning a current World Champion? That has never happened before in the youngster area – but in 2006 that's exactly what Farewell III accomplished. With his victory at the Bundeschampionships in the class for six year old dressage horses in Warendorf, he continued a family tradition: his sire, Fidermark, a dressage stallion trained up to Grand Prix, was a Bundeschampion in his day as well. Farewell III nearly managed this feat at his debut at the Bundeschampionat when he was just three. But he only took second place. Under his trainer, Sandra Kötter, Farewell III's walk and relaxed suppleness are always impressive –characteristics that emphasise the significance of the trademark stallion, Florestan. Farewell III's grandsire produced three young dressage horse World Champions. His son Floriano took sixth place in the free-style as well as team bronze under Steffen Peters at the World Equestrian Games in 2006.

Farewell III's dam, Riga, was Reserve Champion Mare in Westphalia and produced four licensed sons four years in a row. With Rosenkavalier and Apart by the Thoroughbred stallion, Angelo, in the first generations of her pedigree, she is bred similar to Rubinstein. In 2004, the Oldenburg Verband awarded Farewell III the 1c main premium. His off-spring bring top prices at the various foal auctions.
