

Quidam's Rubin



Holsteiner, Bay, Born 1999 16.2 hands

An exceptional stallion in European show jumper breeding

Every year Quidam's Rubin reinforced this early assessment: at his 30 day test in Prussendorf in 2002 he was the best in jumping with a score of 9.32 and received a score of 10.0 five times. In 2003, he presented an excellent first crop that brought high prices at auction, and became the undisputed Oldenburg Main Premium Stallion (Jumping).

In 2004, he won his 70 day test in Neustadt/Dosse with superior results (146.65), by far the best in jumping (145.88) with an excellent 3rd place placing in dressage (128.25). In 2005, five of his sons from his first crop were licensed, including premium stallions in Vechta and Muenster-Handorf.

Like pearls on a string, every generation in the pedigree of this exceptional stallion has a top jumper of French or Holstein performance breeding. The sire, Quidam de Revel, was a successful championship horse in France and Denmark. His highly esteemed genes are now being spread by his sons all over the world. The Dam, Helvecia, belongs to line 144 and connects Landgraf, Caletto I, and Farnese, three of Holstein's most famous performance makers, in her pedigree.
